NEW CCBFC MISSIONARIES

The Outreach Coordination Team recently approved CCBFC's support of two new missionary units. Even though the two share the same last name, they are not related. The new missionaries are:

Dean & Ingrid Ressler – Dean was born into a missionary family on the island of Bonaire. After Bible College he returned to Bonaire as a missionary and while serving there, he met Ingrid. Together they served in a church-development ministry for 24 years. In 2004, they joined the home staff of Fellowship International Mission (FIM) in Allentown. FIM has some 120 missionaries in 27 countries. Working in the Personnel Department, Dean edits the *FIM Connection*, maintains contact with MKs, retirees, and singles in the FIM family and assists with personnel records and reporting. Dean & Ingrid have been members of CCBFC since 2006. Their daughter, Michele, is a student at Word of Life Bible Institute in Florida.

Benjamin & Jill Ressler – Ben & Jill were both raised in CCBFC. Jill is the daughter of CCBFC members Jay and Cindy Musselman. Ben's parents moved away some years ago. The Resslers are serving in a sport's ministry with Missionary Athletes International (MAI). MAI sponsors camps across the USA with over 3000 youth from age 5 to 17 attending each year. MAI has missionaries in the USA, Czech Republic, and Ukraine. Ben is the Assistant General Manager for the Charlotte Eagles soccer team in Charlotte, NC. The focus of the ministry is to train and equip players and coaches to become sports ministers. Ben and Jill have two children – Corban (4) and Tess (8 months).
